The Mobile Clinics will provide a spectrum of medical, nutritional, and psychosocial support activities that will enable patients to remain motivated through their treatments and reintegrate back into normal lives.
2	Provided free helpline and outpatient clinic services to cancer patients	Can Support	Supported CanSupport's Telephone Helpline and Palliative Care Outpatient Clinic that support and offers care needed to manage patient's illness in the best possible way. In
3	Livelihood generation of Persons with Disability	Tender Hearts	To promote livelihood to a generation of persons with intellectual disability, we support a project of the NGO Tender Hearts wherein the persons with intellectual disability are trained to make rugs and mats as a means of their livelihood generation.
4	To setup two women owned spice-based enterprise units at Baran and Chittorgarh districts of Rajasthan	Pehel Foundation and Manjari Trust	Pehel will sponsor the setting up of two women owned spice based units in Chittorgarh and Baran in Rajasthan. Chittorgarh and Baran in Rajasthan were prioritized due to high poverty, low gender equality indicators. The units will process, brand, and market major spices like chili, coriander and turmeric. The women will be trained on aggregation, segregation, processing, packaging, marketing, hygiene etc. The two processing units will generate business and jobs for about 100 women in a sustained way.
5	Training of construction workers	Pehel Foundation and CREDAI CSR Foundation	Pehel in partnership with CREDAI CSR Foundation will train 568 constructions. The training will be in trades like bar-bending, masonry, shuttering, tiling, electrical and plumbing.
